Program of Instruction

First class session will be Sunday at 6:00PM and the last class will be over at 3:00 PM on Saturday. Daily instruction will include comprehensive classroom discussion of mechanics and techniques, New NCAA 2011-2012 Rules AND MECHANICS, The Strike Zone, Handling Situations, Communication, Philosophy of Plate and Base Work, Field Work and Drills. Also included in the course of Instruction are daily actual live game assignments with evaluations of on-field performance. All students will be grouped in accordance with their umpire experience and previous camp experience. All registrations are subject to approval.

- **Session 2 – October 24 – October 30, 2010 *Advanced 3 Man Umpiring Mechanics***

MISSION: This will be the most advanced umpire training camp for Non-professional umpires in the country. This will be a 7-day no holds barred upper level umpire camp geared to teaching the skills required for NCAA Conference level games. We will place umpires in advanced assignments based on camp performance.

Tuition includes 6-night double occupancy, Class Materials, Camp T-shirt, continental breakfast and Box Lunches and drinks.

Our staff is comprised of some of the top Professional and Collegiate Umpires and NCAA Coordinators who are dedicated to sharing the skills and techniques, which have made them successful at the highest levels of the game.

Accommodations
